## Regulations

- Under Gift Aid regulations you are not allowed to give a gift, via a charity, to a close relative.** ("Close relative" means children, grandchildren, parents, grandparents, siblings or the spouses of any of these.)
- Please notify Wycliffe if a) you want to cancel this declaration b) you change your name or address c) you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.
- Under UK tax laws, husbands and wives are taxed separately and therefore we require a separate Gift Aid Declaration for each person who wishes to give under the Gift Aid Scheme.

### Tax Claimed by Wycliffe UK

- Wycliffe will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- Wycliffe will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you gave on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay Wycliffe an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for Wycliffe does not affect your personal tax situation

If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can reclaim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
