Notes

1. **Under Gift Aid regulations you are not allowed to give a gift, via a charity, to a close relative.** ("Close relative" means children, grandchildren, parents, grandparents, siblings or the spouses of any of these.)
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that Wycliffe reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. Under UK tax laws, husbands and wives are taxed separately and we therefore cannot accept a 'joint' Gift Aid Declaration. A **separate** Gift Aid Declaration **must** be completed by each person who wishes to give under the Gift Aid Scheme.
4. If your declaration covers donations you make in the future:
 - please notify the Response Centre if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - you may cancel your declaration at any time by notifying the Response Centre – Wycliffe will then make no further tax reclaims on donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
5. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to the tax that Wycliffe reclaims, you should cancel your declaration (see note 2).
6. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can reclaim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
