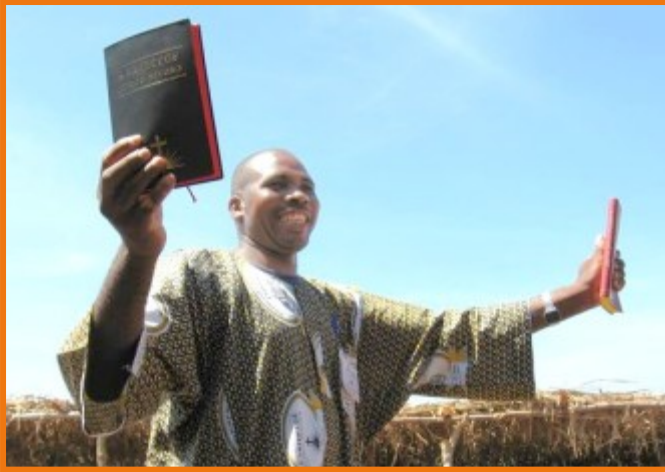


Wycliffe and Me
