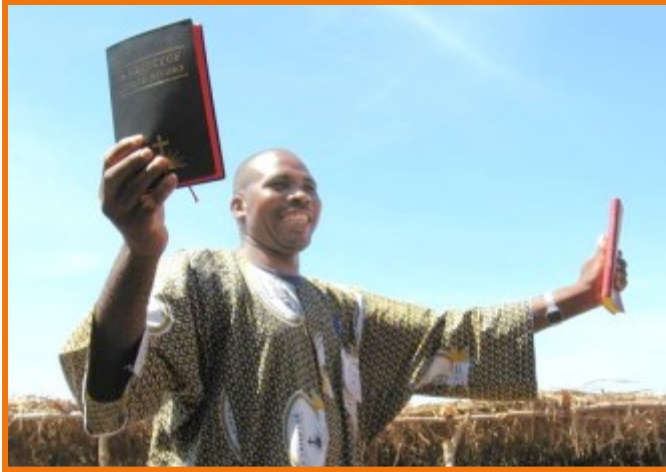


# Wycliffe and Me
